



Ch Thuerry covers some 340 hectares, and crosses over the three villages of Villecroze, Flayosc and Tourtour. This unique site is protected from the wind and has an ideal exposure to sunlight. The soil is composed of clay, chalk, and limestone. Cultivation is carried out with great care to produce outstanding wines of typical character of the region using both ancestral and modern techniques of wine making. Harvest is done by hand into small cases, so as not to crush the grapes, then sorted and transferred by gravity into the winery. Skin contact varies from wine to wine, variations are according to the character that the wine grower wishes to obtain. Filtration is minimal, so as best to preserve the characteristics of each wine. Bottling is done on site.

The 2014 Rose is composed of Grenache and Cinsault. This wine is full bodied rose with aromas of mature fruit, the grip, flavor and length transforms the wine itself into a freshness one can only experience and appreciate in the great rose's of Provence.
